Dr. Aruna Mesquita e Noronha extended a warm welcome to the alumni members.

The members agreed to use the alumni fund to help the needy students but were of the opinion that there has to be a criteria and capping for such funding. The details about the scholarship under the alumni association should be mentioned in the college prospectus as well as the college website so that the students are aware about the scholarship. The members proposed that 2-3 students who fulfil the required criteria can be awarded the scholarship.

The Chairman suggested that the alumni association can also contact the college alumni by sending them e-mail and then identifying those alumni who are willing to sponsor the fees of the needy students.

Mr. Rajesh Bhatikar, Administrator of S.S. Dempo College of Commerce & Economics, informed the members about the New education policy.

Mr. Bhatikar stressed on the importance of bridge courses for the higher secondary students and told about the course design of Dempo higher secondary students of commerce stream and also spoke about the way the syllabus is framed. The Chairman asked the members how the syllabus for B.com Course is designed and how it could be revised. Mr. Bhatikar informed him that the BOS committee drafts the syllabus which is then approved by the Academic Council. The Chairman suggested that the BOS should comprise of both academicians or subject experts as well as members of industry and trade so that the syllabus is both practical and theoretical and not just theoretical.
