
Report on NATIONAL VOTERS' DAY PLEDGE


Sessions on water conservation



REPORT - TWO-DAY WEBINAR ON 'INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS AND IP MANAGEMENT"

The Institution's Innovation Council under the directives of MoE's Innovation Cell, Governmen t of India, Ministry of Education Initiative and All India Council for Technical Education organized a Two-Day Webinar on the theme 'Intellectual Property Rights and IP Management' on Thurs. 25 - March and Fri. 26-March-2021. The programme was coordinated by IIC Member and Asst. Prof. Siddhesh Narvekar.

The webinar was split into four sessions as was taken on Google Meet platform. The sessions were graced by four abled experts who enlightened the participants on various modules of Intellectual Property Rights.

- 1. First session, a combination of inaugural and technical session was held on Thurs. 25th March 2021 12:00 p.m. onwards in the presence of our college Principal Dr. Radhika Nayak, staff and students from Dempo college and other colleges from Goa. Mast. Parth Rahalkar from S.Y.B.Com. 'F' gave an auspicious beginning to the programme with an invocation song. Later, the college Principal Dr. Radhika Nayak welcomed the virtual gathering and thanked the resource persons for having accepted the invitations, and accepting request to conduct sessions for the webinar and to enlighten on various aspects of IPR. She further added how the New Education Policy highlights the significance of innovation and invention through research, and how the webinar will definitely give information about ways in which it needs to be protected and implemented in areas of business. She also thanked the IIC team for putting the webinar together. The session was conducted by Dr. G. Shaber Ali, Officiating Principal of V. M. Salgaocar College of Law, Panaji – Goa. Ms. Sudeepta Mallya, the Student coordinator of this Webinar introduced the resource person. Sir Dr. Shaber Ali spoke on 'Perception of IPR and Its Components' and gave an insightful thought on what is IPR, to whom IPR is important, the important components and subject matters coming under IPR areas, such as, Patents, Trademarks, Copyrights and trade secrets. He also spoke on protection of industrial designs, geographical indicators, layout design, Integrated Circuits, legislation of IPR on biological diversity, information technology, plant varieties, traditional knowledge, creativity and entertainment implications of Plagiarism, nonpatentable inventions. The session was concluded by question answer round. The session was compered by the programme coordinator Asst. Prof. Siddhesh S. Narvekar.
- 2. Second technical session was held between 3:00 p.m. to 4:15 pm on the same day, i.e., 25th March 2021. Dr. Ranjana Ferrao Souza Cordeiro, Assistant Professor at V. M. Salgaocar College of Law, Panaji Goa took the charge of the session and spoke on the topic 'Protecting Trademarks in Goa'. Ms. Alisha Pilgaonkar, the Student of M. Com. Part II and student member of Institution's Innovation Council of our college introduced the resource person Dr. Ranjana Ferrao Souza Cordeiro. Ma'am Ranjana gave a fruitful presentation where she spoke on what are trademarks, the need for protecting trademarks, rules that one needs to keep in mind while registering a trademark and the consequences for not registering a trademark. Ranjana ma'am addressed the queries of the participants at the end of the session. The session was compered by the programme coordinator Asst. Prof. Siddhesh S. Narvekar.

- 3. The third technical session was held on Fri. 26th March 2021 between 12:30 p.m. to 1:45 p.m. The resource person for the session was Mrs. Suwarna Surlakar, the Director of FunMinds Learning Tech. Pvt. Ltd. Ma'am Suwarna gave valuable insight on a much-needed topic for the commerce students, i.e., 'Intellectual Property Rights for Technology and Business'. Ms. Saniya Khan, the student of T.Y.B.Com. 'E' introduced Mrs. Suwarna Surlakar to the audience. Mrs. Suwarna Surlakar gave insights on what is intellectual property, why is intellectual property protected and beneficiaries of IPR, its importance, kinds of intellectual outputs and ways to protect it with special emphasis on technology, software and business units. All this was explained through case studies of turmeric, Mc Donald's vs McCurry, Facebook vs Teachbook, and Patent infringement between Apple and Samsung-Mrs. Suwarna answered the questions of the participants at the end of the session. The session was compered by the programme coordinator Asst. Prof. Siddhesh S. Narvekar.
- 4. The fourth technical cum valedictory session was held between 3:00 p.m. to 4:15 p.m. on the same day, i.e., Fri. 26th March 2021. The programme was compered by Ms. Saniya Khan, the student of T.Y.B.Com. 'E'. Ms. Alisha Pilgaonkar, the Student of M. Com. Part II and student member of Institution's Innovation Council of our college introduced the resource person Dr. T. Ramakrishna, Professor at National Law School of India University, Bengaluru who spoke on the topic 'Patents and Public Interest'. Sir Ramakrishna gave details on what is Patent, how to obtain patent, rationale of patent system, i.e., what are the requirements to be satisfied for getting a patent, what do the patent statistics at national level and the global level indicate, what gets protected with the patent system, how to distinguish between discovery and invention, the limitations and exceptions of the patentee's rights imposed in the public interest. He focused on the pharma patents and public interest flexibilities within the patent system, Artificial Intelligence and the Patent system, what happens to these technical standards, and standards that are helpful to the public welfare. The session was kept open for queries thereafter. The programme coordinator Mr. Siddhesh Narvekar proposed the vote of thanks.

A total of 142 participants were present in all the four sessions. The e-certificates of participation were given to the participants on request through e-mails (15 certificates issued for technical session 1, 27 for session 2, 65 for session 3 and 25 for session 4. The participants were requested to fill the Google Forms for the same. The feedback with regards to the Webinar and individual sessions were also acquired in these forms.




World Water Day Presentation and Awareness
